Placement into a program of studies for freshman year is based on the results of the TACHS examination and the Preston Placement Test. Our goal is to ensure our students' success by placing them in the appropriate level course. Our Placement Test will help us assess each student's level of mastery and ensure they are placed accordingly. The placement test is scheduled for March 6, 2021 from 8:30 am to 11:30 am.

Because this test will be in-person, we will be adhering to all state and locally mandated safety protocols. We ask that students bring their own items to the test. These items include:
